The Hennepin County Public Defender's Office provides a select group of law students with a unique, educational experience working in one of Minnesota's largest law firms. Our program is designed for law students who are interested in indigent defense, display characteristics of promising future public defenders, possess strong research and writing skills, and have an impeccable work ethic.

Law Clerks support Assistant Public Defenders with a wide range of projects.

Law clerks work hand in hand with experienced criminal defense attorneys on misdemeanor, felony, juvenile, child protection and appellate cases. They complete research and writing projects including motions and memoranda to be filed in court. Law clerks are also given the opportunity to observe and participate in client interviews and case strategy meetings. Those with student practice certification may argue motions they have written and may assist lawyers at bail hearings, evidentiary hearings, sentencing hearings, or trials.

Summer law clerks are invited to attend public defender trainings and field trips throughout the summer.
